Taipei boasts excellent infrastructure, providing a secure and convenient living environment. It is closely connected to global high-tech industries and has become a hub of innovation, making it an ideal place for both local and international entrepreneurs to launch their ventures.

To provide startups with comprehensive services and support, the Taipei City Government established a One-Stop Service StartUP@Taipei Office. This office offers counseling services, incentives and subsidies, preferential loans, ecosystem connections, and innovation bases. Additionally, the city introduced its "Three Arrows for Startups" policy, focusing on three pillars: capital investment, talent attraction, and facilitating business deals. Through these initiatives, Taipei aims to attract key resources and stakeholders, solidifying its position as a truly "Founder-Friendly City".

Taipei City's Innovation and Startup Ecology

A Place to Start up

Taipei is the leading destination for startups in Taiwan. According to the FINDIT database by Taiwan's Ministry of Economic Affairs , Taiwan had 9,714 startups launched between 2010-2025, with 4,124 of them setting up their operations in Taipei. This accounts for nearly 42% of all startups in Taiwan. Taipei is home to over half of the country's startups, accelerators, and co-working spaces. More than 80% of Taiwan's startup investment firms are also based in the city. These figures highlight Taipei's central role in Taiwan's startup ecosystem.



Top Choice of Investments by Foreign Companies

Taipei attracts more than 70% of foreign investments and nearly 70% of foreign companies operating in Taiwan. Meanwhile, emerging industries—such as digital technology, biomedical innovation, lifestyle services, cultural and creative design, and MICE—have grown rapidly in recent years. Taipei's comprehensive industry development is focused on R&D, innovation, and high-added-value industries. In response to this development, Taipei City actively invites international enterprise operation headquarters, R&D centers, and emerging technology and IT service industries to establish their offices in the city.

Plentiful Industrial Momentum

Taipei's growth strategy is powered by two key engines: building an AI-driven smart city and cultivating a founder-friendly environment. These efforts aim to develop a digitally intelligent, green innovation economy that fuels industrial growth.

It connects its Nangang Software Park, Neihu Technology Park, and Beitou Shilin Technology Park to form a Taipei Technology Corridor focused on R&D orientation. Furthermore, it introduces innovative applications to the city for building up an effective system for urban governance, marketing, tourism, traffic management, healthcare and education. The government also provides strong assistance and support to startups, increasing the growth momentum.

Outstanding Talent with Competitiveness

Taipei attracts top talent and is home to numerous academic institutions. Its educational level is persistently recognized by both domestic and international surveys. According to the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU)'s Livability Survey, Taipei has repeatedly earned top scores in education-related indicators. The city is also recognized as one of the best university hubs globally. This ensures businesses have access to highly qualified talent and builds a strong foundation for the startup ecosystem.

Financial Industry

Taipei is Taiwan's financial hub, hosting over 80% of the nation's financial headquarters and venture capital firms, supported by 200,000 professionals and diverse investment opportunities.

Tourism Industry

Taipei, renowned for its cultural and natural attractions, history, safety, and convenience, attracts 90% of Taiwan's visitors and ranks as the world's second-best city for travel.

To provide entrepreneurs an optimal environment and attract both domestic and international startups to establish themselves in Taipei, public land, existing facilities, and private-sector resources have been leveraged to create innovation hubs. Currently, a total of 14 operational bases have been established, encompassing a floor area of approximately 242,515 square meters, housing 589 active resident teams.

It is expected that 3 bases will be opened by 2027.

Based on the surrounding industrial characteristics and development trends of each base, corresponding industries will be planned to attract emerging industries in the relevant fields to develop.








StartSphere Taipei Event

StartSphere Taipei, organized by the Taipei City Government, is an annual flagship international event that showcases innovation and entrepreneurship in consumer tech, digital entertainment, fintech, and AI applications. Through forums, showcases, networking sessions, and global investor matchmaking, it serves as a platform connecting startups with international markets, capital, and technology. The event gathers entrepreneurs, investors, unicorns, and media from across Asia, the Americas, and Europe for meaningful exchanges and startup showcases—showcasing Taipei's dynamic potential as a global innovation hub.

In 2024, The Taipei City Government launched the "Global Pass" to assist Taipei's startups in accessing international co-working spaces and help them to link to local resources, funds, and connections as well. On the other hand, Taipei City teams up with its sister and friendship cities officially to establish "Cities Startup Partners" to promote inter-city cooperation and share entrepreneurship resources, and then invites global startups or specialists to come to grow and develop their business in Taipei.

Organizations that procure products through the TOPS platform may receive commendations and monetary rewards. The "Sustainability and Shared Prosperity" award highlights outstanding efforts in innovative collaboration and sustainable practices.
